### **Monday, August 5 - Parent Orientation Meetings:**

- Parents of NEW K4-12th grade students: 6:30 PM in the cafeteria (Sligh Center)
- Parents of ALL K4-5th grade students: 5:30 PM, 7:00 PM or 8:00 PM
  - K4-2nd Grade will meet in the teachers' classrooms
  - Grade 3 - Room E270 (Mrs. Stump's classroom); Grade 4 - E250 (Mrs. Mudger's classroom); Grade 5 - Wonder Room
  - If you would like to meet the Special Area teachers (PE, art, music, Spanish, library), please attend a session in the Elementary Art Room (E155) at 5:30 PM, 7:00 PM or 8:00 PM.
  - Special Program teachers and Discovery Program teachers will present in their classrooms at 5:30 PM, 7:00 PM and 8:00 PM.

All elementary **parents\*** are strongly encouraged to attend either the 5:30 PM, 7:00 PM or 8:00 PM session in the assigned location as noted above. The same information will be presented in each session. If you have children in multiple grade levels, this will allow you to visit all of the sessions. ### **Tuesday, August 6 - Meet The Teachers:**

**8:00-10:00 AM** - Parents and students in K4 through 5th Grade are invited to drop by the classrooms, meet teachers and bring in school supplies. Students can come meet the Special Area teachers in the Elementary Art Room (E155).

### **General Orientation Information for Orientation Day on Tuesday, August 6:**

- **Wrap Pacs (Grades K4-5th):** If you ordered a school supply pack, it will be delivered to the child's homeroom class. These are not available for purchase at orientation.
- **Agendas:** All elementary students receive an agenda, which will be ready for your child in his/her classroom.
- **Bibles:** All elementary students in grades 1-5 are required to have an ESV Bible for class. All first graders will receive a new ESV Bible (covered by the Activity Fee). New students in K4-5th grade will receive a Bible. Homeroom teachers will distribute Bibles to students. All returning students in grades 2-5 should bring the Bible they were previously given, or they can purchase a new one in Student Services for \$10.

**Class Rosters (Grades K4-5th)** will be posted outside the teachers' classrooms on Orientation Day. Teachers will email postcards to students a few days before orientation to welcome students to their new class.
